The Skid Plate has been designed for easy installation & pre-painted with a very durable paint (Dupli-Color/High Perf Graphite Wheel).

Safety Precautions: Important Safety 2.

- A. Park on a firm level area.
- B. Stop engine, set brake, remove key and wait for all moving parts to stop before servicing, adjusting or unplugging.
- C. Block up before working beneath unit.

3. Tools/torque/Parts required:

- **A.** /Wrenches 1/2" , 9/16" , 22 mm (7/8" will work)
- B. Sockets: 1/2", 9/16", 22 mm (7/8" will work)
- D. Torque wrench (22 to 115Lb-Ft).
- E. Small jack.
- F. Wrenches or socket (1/2"@10Lb-Ft) trap door/U-Bolts.











Assembly Instructions: Amportant Safety 4.

- . 1 Once you have followed the safety precautions & have removed the skid plate from its packaging, please take note of all the parts & follow the assembly instructions
- .2 Free up the work place of all disturbance & clutter. Take your time installing it (This can be easily done by one person in 15 to 60 minutes). Have a good look under your tractor, Mower deck will have to be removed to properly install the skid plate.
- .3 The skid plate has been partially preassembled. You will need to dissemble all of the parts from the skid plate.
- .4 Remove factory oil filter guard is you have one.



Remove the two rear bolts at the back of the 3 point hitch. These shall be reuse in step .4

.4 Install the rear skid plate,

The rear of the skid plate will go over the top of the plate. (See above IMAGE 2 REAR BOLTS) The front of the skid plate can be supported with a jack. Line up the skid plate in a manner that it lines up with the hole on the frame. Check clearances around the skid plate so that there are no points of contact other than the mounting locations.

Reuse the two rear bolts & washers that was remove with the original bolts. Do not tighten the bolts.





.5 Install the the U-Bolt.



.6 Reinstall the two nylon nuts & washers on the u-Bolt andtightening only, this leave some play that will make it easier to line up the skid plate.





- .7 Tighten the rear bolts to 90ft/lbs, once everything lines up.
- .8 Tighten the the nuts on the U-bolt.
- Check everything out for clearances & binding. Recheck nuts, clearance around the plate & bolts every oil change. If attachment is installed, check their clearances with the skid plate & the mower deck (put the Mower Deck in the lowest & highest position. The End on the U-Bolt can be cut down.

lacktriangleImportant f Safety If there is a point of contact, do not continue to use the skid plate on the tractor.
